As previously announced, in connection with its public offering (the "Offering"), TXO Partners, L.P. (the "Partnership") granted the underwriters of its Offering a 30-day option to purchase additional common units representing limited partner interests in TXO (the "common units") at the Offering price, less underwriting discounts and commissions. On July 2, 2024, the Partnership consummated the sale of an additional 975,000 common units at the Offering price of \$20.00 per common unit, resulting in additional gross proceeds of \$19,500,0000 before deducting underwriting discounts and commissions.
